The total includes 412 projects under the PBO plus all other Colorado projects.

<sup>2</sup> Includes projects consulted on after Recovery Implementation Program Initiation (January 1988) which are eligible to participate in the Yampa Programmatic Biological Opinion. The Yampa River PBO covers up to 167,854 AF of historic depletions and up to 53,532 AF of new depletions. The totals include 70 projects in Colorado and 4 projects in Wyoming under the PBO plus all other Colorado and Wyoming projects.
